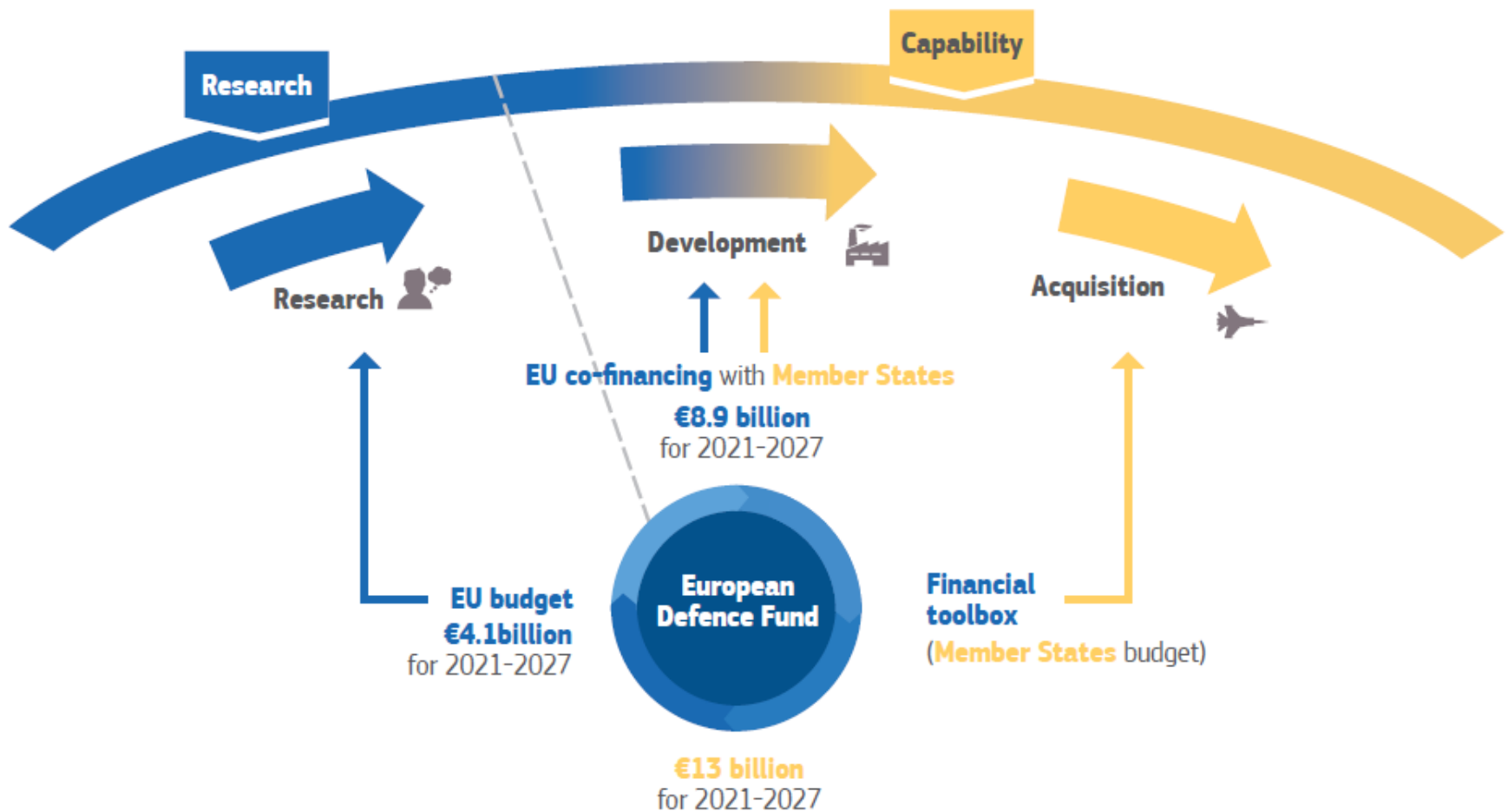

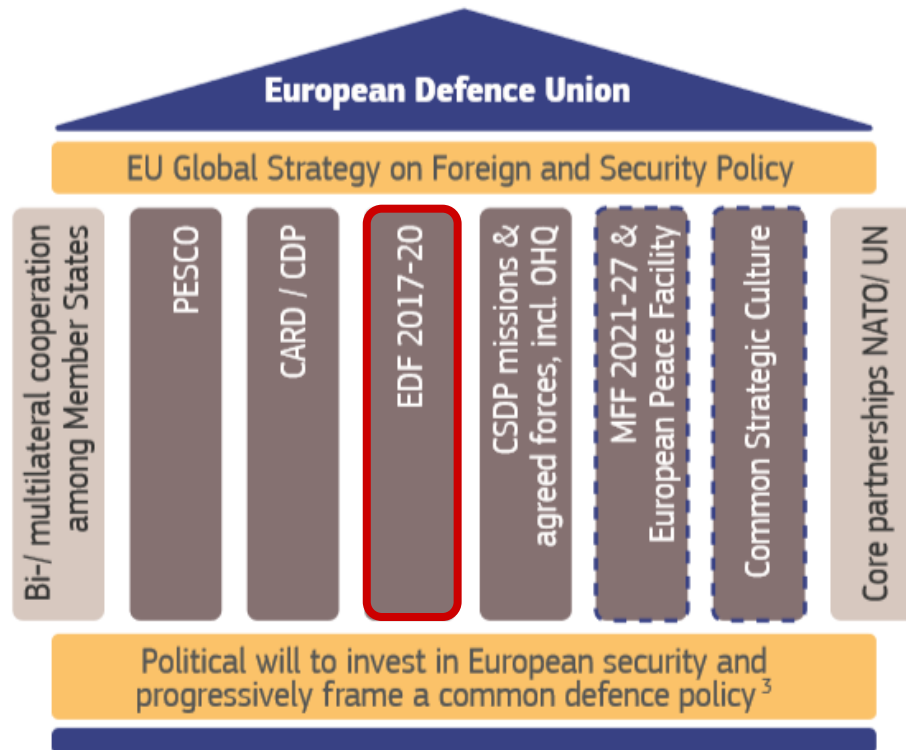

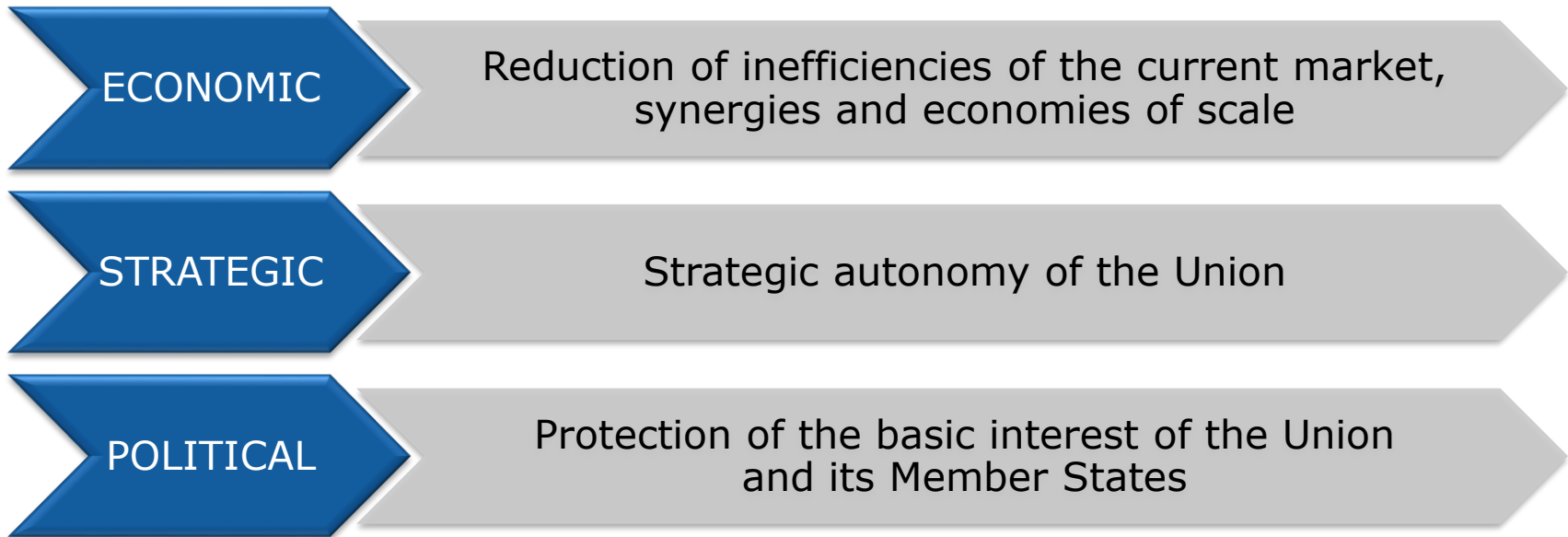

## European Defence Fund

- **Budget: EUR 13 billion** for 2021 to 2027 (EUR 4.1bn for research actions and EUR 8.9bn for development actions)
- **Integrated approach** covering the research and development activities – to strengthen the uptake of research results
- **Annual work-programmes**
- **Disruptive technologies for defence:** dedicated support to ensure long term strategic autonomy for Europe
- Commission proposal adopted on June, 13<sup>th</sup> 2018; **partial agreement reached between the co-legislators;** final adoption depends on discussions on the long-term budget

## **What can be funded?**

- Actions covering both new and upgrade of existing products and technologies in at least one of the following areas:
  - Activities aiming at new knowledge and defence technologies
  - Feasibility studies
  - Prototypes
  - Qualification / Proof of suitability
  - Technologies to reduce life cycle costs
  - Activities aiming at interoperability and autonomy
  - Definitions / design studies
  - Product tests
  - Certification
- Significant percentage of the overall budget to benefit disruptive technologies for defence



## Eligibility

- **Cooperation projects** between at least **three legal entities** established in at least **three different Member States/Associated Countries**
- Only **entities established in the Union** or in an Associated Country which are not controlled by third countries/companies
- Exception if conditions relating to the **security interests of the Union** and its Member States are met
  - No risk in the ability to perform the action (security of supply)
  - Classified information are not accessible to 3rd country entity (sensitive information protected)
  - No Transfer of IP (IPR remains in the EU)
- **Cooperation** with companies based outside the Union **possible**, but costs are not eligible



# In current budgetary period (2014-2020)

- **Preparatory Action for Defence Research – PADR**  
**2017-2020**  
**€90 million**
- **European Defence Industrial Development Programme – EDIDP**  
**2019-2020**  
**€500 million**

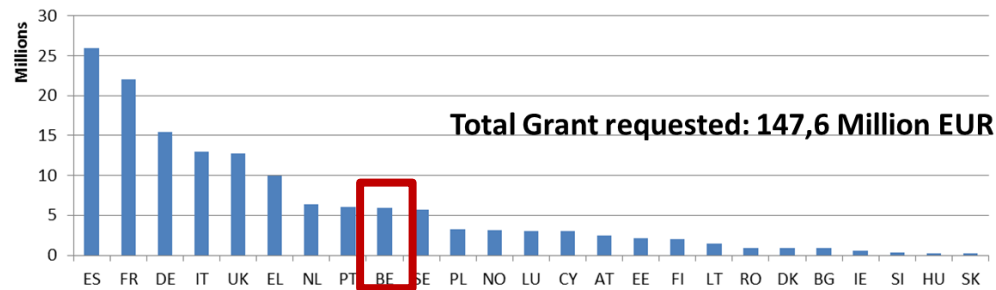


# Preparatory Action Defence Research

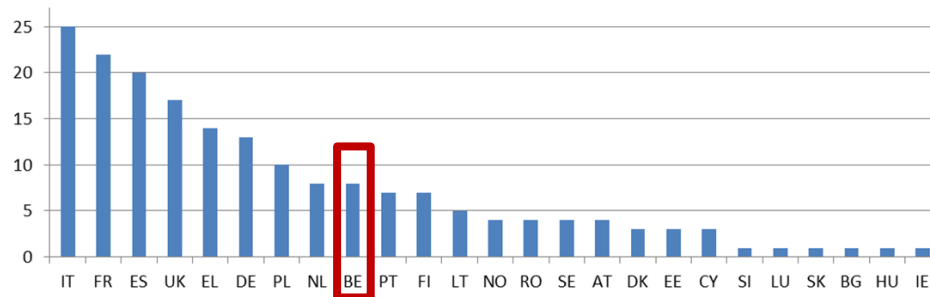
- Implemented through annual work programmes and calls for proposals
  - **Calls 2017 and 2018:**
    - 5 projects running (of calls 2017)
    - 2018 evaluations finalised – 3 grant agreement in preparation phase
  - **Calls 2019:**
    - 3 Calls open until 28 August
    - 1 Call open until 3 September
- 10 projects expected to be awarded

2017 PADR Proposals - Grant Requested

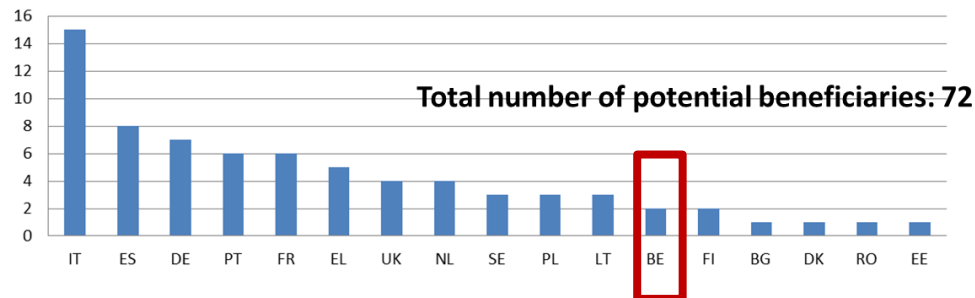
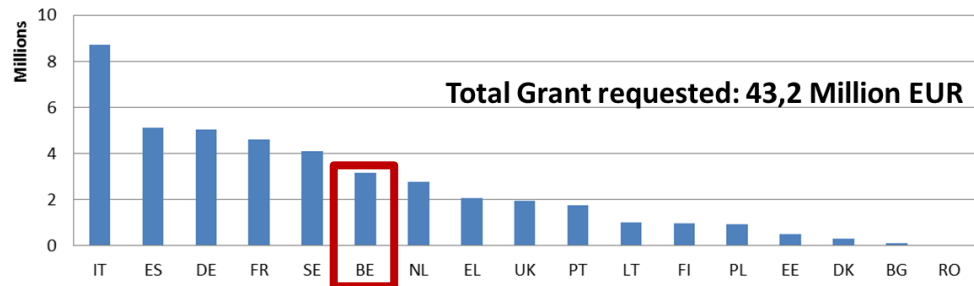


PADR 2017 Proposals - 187 unique participants

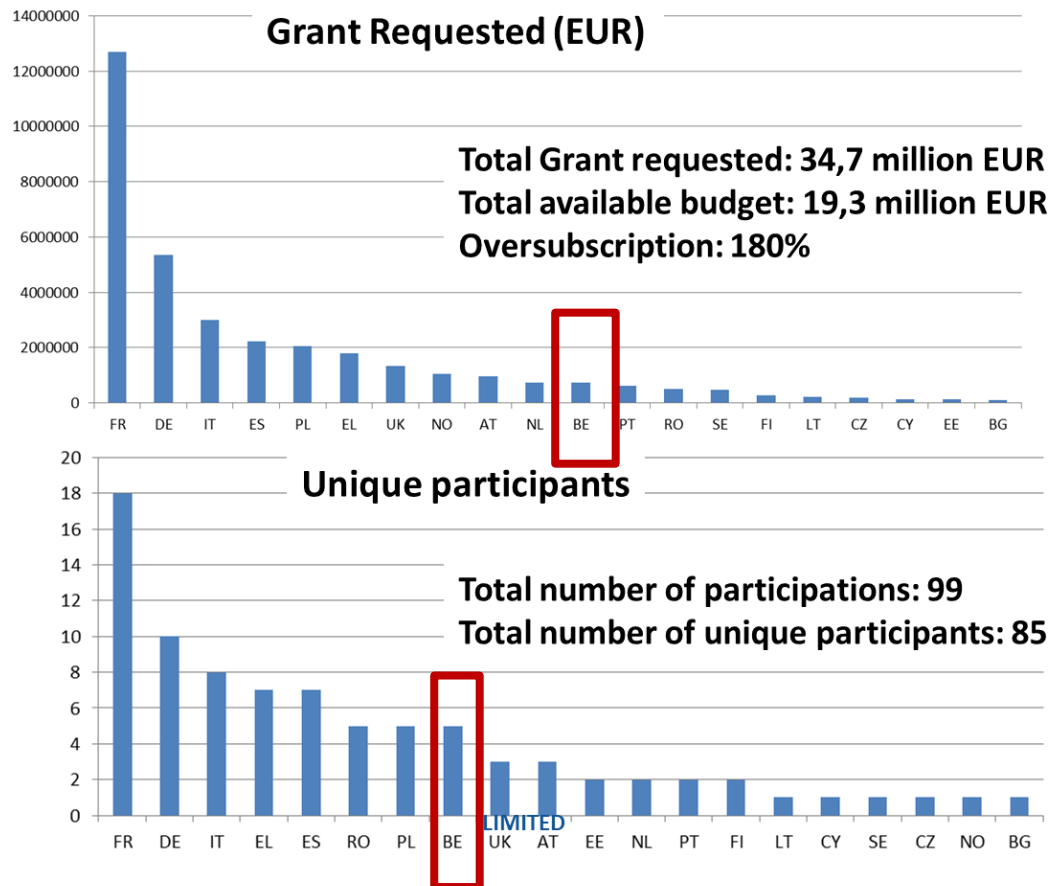

## PADR Calls 2019

### Call – **Electromagnetic Spectrum Dominance**

Combined radar, communications, and electronic warfare functions based on European Active Electronically Scanned Arrays for military applications

→ not more than 1 project to be funded

### Call – **Future Disruptive Defence Technologies**

- Challenging the future (*no predefined topics*) **3 projects**
- Emerging game changers (*5 predefined topics: autonomous positioning, AI for defence, quantum for defence, long range effects, augmenting soldier capacity*) **5 projects**

### Call – **Unmanned systems**

**1 project**

Interoperability standards for military unmanned systems

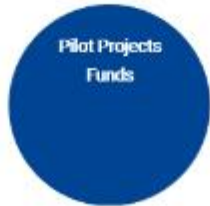

## Pilot Projects and Preparatory Actions (PPPA)

Pilot projects (PP) and Preparatory Actions (PA) introduce new initiatives that might turn into standing EU funding programmes.

A Pilot Project is an initiative of an experimental nature designed to test the feasibility of an action and its usefulness and lasts not more than two years. A Preparatory Action - normally the successor of a successful pilot project on the same matter - is designed to prepare new actions like EU policies, legislation, programmes etc. with funding for not more than three years.

# EDIDP: European Defence Industrial Development Programme

- **Regulation** adopted in **July 2018**
- Duration: **2 years → 2019-2020**
- Budget: **EUR 500 million** for the period 2019-2020
- EU support in the form of **grants** awarded to industrial consortia
- Co-financing: up to 100% of total eligible costs for all items with an exception of prototyping where the co-funding cannot exceed 20% (excluding bonuses) + indirect costs flatrate of 25%
- Call for proposals: deadline: **29 August 2019**

# EXAMPLE

## Call EDIDP-MUGS-2019

### Multipurpose unmanned ground system

- *1 topic addressed in this call*
  - **EDIDP-MUGS-2019:** Multipurpose architecture for unmanned ground systems and solutions for systems integration and manned-unmanned teaming
- *Possible game-changer for future land operations*
  - **reduced danger to civilian populations, armed forces personnel and manned platforms**
  - **increased robustness, sustainability and resilience of ground systems**
- *Targeted activities*
  - **at least design or system prototyping**
- *Budget*
  - **€30,6 million**

# EDIDP Activities and Requirements

- A proposal will only be considered **eligible if its content corresponds to the topic** description against which it is submitted and if all **eligibility criteria** related to the **targeted activity** are fulfilled by the time of submission
- The action shall address the **development phase** of new **defence products** and technologies and/or the upgrade of existing products and technologies;
- Where addressing **upgrade**, the use of **pre-existing information** needed to carry out the action shall not be subject to a restriction by a third country or by a third-country entity, directly, or indirectly through one or more intermediary undertakings;
- The **results of actions** which receive funding under the Programme shall not be subject to control or restriction by a third country or by a third-country entity, directly, or indirectly through one or more intermediate undertakings, including in terms of technology transfer.

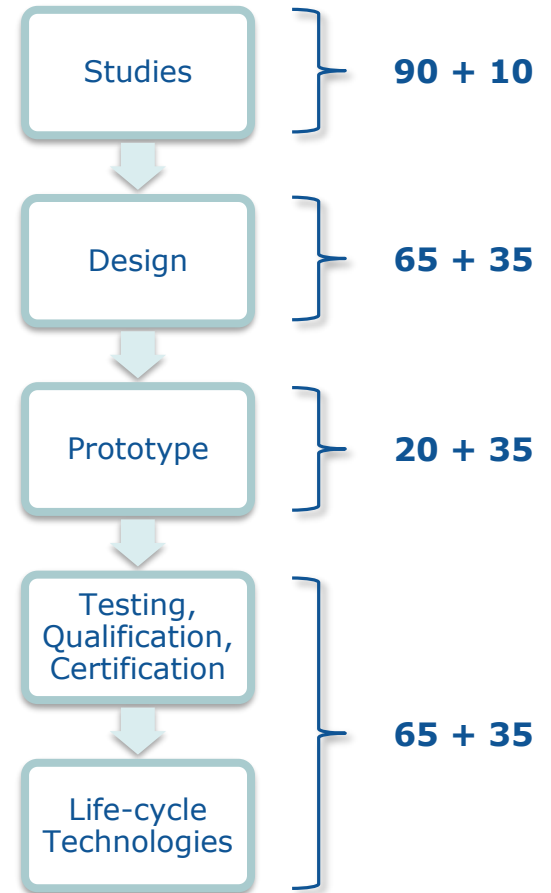
## Evidence of co-financing by MS [e.g. Letter of Comfort / Guarantee / AdHoc] :

- Document identifying the financial contributors and specifying on what hypothesis (EU support level) their financial contribution will cover the rest of the costs

## Evidence of common military requirements and common technical specifications [e.g. MoU / LoI / Contract] :

- Document providing evidence that the activity is based on common requirements jointly agreed by at least two Member States.
- Document providing evidence that at the activity will be based on common technical specifications jointly agreed by the supporting MS.
- Fulfilment of these criteria will be verified during audits and project verifications. Any major changes to the project should be supported by an assessment of its impact on the commonality of requirements / technical specification.
